Hike Mt. Monadnock

Venturing toward a positive impact with Northeast Mountaineering one step at a time.

JAFFERY, NEW HAMPSHIRE: A reasonable, scenic 2 hour drive from Boston brings you to Mount Monadnock. At an elevation of 3,165 feet it is one of the outstanding peaks of the northeast. It is an isolated mountain which offers far reaching views from the Boston skyline to Mt. Greylock, MA up the Green Mountains as far as Mount Killington, VT and as far as Mount Washington, NH 105 air miles away. Monadnock was bared by fires over 200 years ago. The upper 300 to 400 feet of the mountain is exposed bare rock with 5 spruce covered ridges that emanate outward from the mountain with open crags and exposed ledges offering many scenic and spectacular views. Golf Tournament

Chiseled from granite the course at The Shattuck speaks volumes about our Veterans.

Carved from the granite foothills of Mt. Monadnock, The Shattuck is one of the most visually stunning golf courses you'll ever play. Course architect Brian Silva calls The Shattuck Club, "The Most Spectacular Setting I've ever come across." (New England Golf Magazine)

This is a course that lives in harmony with its surroundings, spanning acres of natural wetlands that serve not only as hazards to the golfer, but home to a wide variety of wildlife including mink, fox, deer, moose, beaver, otter and the great blue heron. The golf holes themselves stand in striking contrast to the woods and wetlands, with lush bent grass on every tee, fairway and green.

Aidclimb Golf Tournament will be played at par 72. Men will play the white tees with a yardage of 5,454. Women, children and seniors will play the yellow tees with a yardage of 4,385. It is a four-person, scramble format tournament.
